
The Presidential Medal of Freedom, the nation's highest civilian award for distinguished Americans, will be presented to the Reverend Benjamin Hooks, son of Memphis, on November 5, 2007. Dr. Hooks is the first Memphian to receive the medal which is given for outstanding contributions in the nation's public interest and in private accomplishments. Judge Hooks served as the South's first African American trial judge, the Executive Director of the NAACP, and a Commissioner of the Federal Communications Commission. He presently serves as Chairman of the National Civil Rights Museum and is Pastor of Middle Baptist Church in Memphis.

It was a great honor for me to receive a call from Rev. Hooks asking me to accompany him to the White House, as his congressman and personal friend, to share this important moment in his life. It is because of this important event that my Seniors Issues Forum, originally scheduled for November 5, had to be postponed until Tuesday, November 13.
