Dear Governor Lee:

I write today to express my urgent concerns regarding COVID-19 vaccine access in Shelby County. I have heard from constituents, reviewed the data and am unable to reconcile the state's vaccine distribution formula with publicly available information.

As you know, Black Americans are dying from COVID-19 at disproportionately high rates. Of the 1,169 Memphians who have died thus far, 673 were Black.¹ It is unconscionable that Shelby County is the county which, by the state's own calculations, has the lowest percentage of its population vaccinated.²

Shelby County has acted in good faith throughout this public health crisis and has taken the appropriate steps to issue stay-at-home orders and mask mandates despite the state's reticence to issue state-wide guidance. Yet recent news reports indicate that the county is last when it comes to vaccination rates.³ These reports contradict your Administration's announced policy of giving inner-city neighborhoods and rural areas an additional 5 percent increase in vaccine allocations.
